Coverage

The **warranty start date** is the date of delivery of the engine to the first retail purchaser, or the first use of the engine in a leased, rented or loaned unit, or when the engine has operated 50 hours in demonstration, whichever occurs first.

Extended Major Components Warranty

The **Extended Major Components Warranty** covers failed major components and **progressively damaged major components only**.

The labor and material cost to repair a failed major component, if not more than the cost of a new major component, is covered. **Labor cost for access to a failed part is not covered.**

Labor and material cost to repair any major component item according to warranty-approved salvage procedure which is progressively damaged by a warrantable failure of one or more of these major components is covered.

Limitations

This warranty excludes all engines branded and sold as Cummins Recreational and Light Commercial products.

Cummins will pay **reasonable travel expenses** for mechanics to travel to and from a repair dock to repair a warrantable failure. The owner is responsible for the cost of towing the boat to the repair dock and for all associated docking and harbor charges.

Failures of belt(s) and non-shielded hoses are covered only during the first 90 days of the warranty period.

Non-Cummins accessories are covered for the duration of the base engine warranty when supplied by Cummins as part of a Marine Propulsion package unit. Otherwise, non-Cummins accessories are not covered.

Cummins is not responsible for failures of marine maintenance components supplied by Cummins beyond 90 days after the coverage start date. Marine maintenance components include, but are not limited to: zinc plugs, oil filters, fuel filters, air filters, water filters, fuel/water separator filters, expansion tank pressure caps.
