*Coverage continues for one year with unlimited hours from the date of delivery of the Package to the first user, or from the date the Package is first leased, rented or loaned, or when the Package has been operated for 50 hours, whichever occurs first.	

This Warranty applies to new Packages (as defined below) sold by Cummins and delivered to the first user on or after January 1, 2012, that are used in Marine (Offshore) applications anywhere in the world where Cummins approved service is available. Different Warranty Coverage is provided for Packages used for land based electrical power generation and industrial applications.

A Package will be identified by a data plate having a unique Package Serial Number, which is approved and supplied by Cummins and is installed by a Cummins Center of Excellence ("COE").

BASE PACKAGE WARRANTY

This Warranty covers any failures of the Package, under normal use and service, which result from a defect in material or factory workmanship (Warrantable Failure).

For the purpose of this Bulletin, the 'Package' consists of the non-engine accessories and components purchased and delivered by a Cummins COE to the selling Cummins distributor as part of an integrated unit including a Cummins engine and other accessories and components, e.g. base rail, cooling package, transmission, driveline, charging or main power alternator and control panel. Engine Warranty coverage is not

included as part of this Bulletin. A separate Warranty exists for the engine. Reference Worldwide Marine Commercial Propulsion and Auxiliary Products legal bulletins for specific details on engine and related components. (3381775)

This Warranty specifically excludes any part listed on the Package Dataplate as being Customer Supplied.

Coverage begins with the sale of the Package by Cummins. Coverage continues for one year with unlimited hours from the date of delivery of the Package to the first user, or from the date the Package is first leased, rented or loaned, or when the Package has been operated for 50 hours, whichever occurs first.

These Warranties are made to all Owners in the chain of distribution, and Coverage continues to all subsequent Owners until the end of the periods of Coverage.

Responsibilities

DURING THE BASE PACKAGE WARRANTY

Cummins will pay for all parts and labor needed to repair the damage to the Package resulting from a Warrantable Failure.

Cummins will pay for the lubricating oil, antifreeze, filter elements and other maintenance items that are not reusable due to a Warrantable Failure.

Cummins will pay reasonable costs for mechanics to travel to and from the repair dock, including meals, mileage and lodging, when the repair is performed at the site of the failure.

Cummins will pay reasonable labor costs for Package removal and reinstallation when necessary to repair a Warrantable Failure.

Owner Responsibilities

DURING THE BASE PACKAGE WARRANTY

Owner is responsible for the cost of lubricating oil, antifreeze, filter elements and other maintenance items replaced during Warranty repairs unless such items are not reusable due to the Warrantable Failure.

Owner is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Package as specified in the applicable Operation and Maintenance Manual. Owner is also responsible for providing proof that all recommended maintenance has been performed.

Before the expiration of the applicable Warranty, Owner must notify a Cummins distributor, authorized dealer or other repair location approved by Cummins of any Warrantable Failure and make the product available for repair by such facility. Service locations are listed in the Cummins Worldwide Service Locator at cummins.com.

Owner is responsible for the repair of non-Cummins accessories and components not covered by this Warranty, "downtime" expenses, cargo damage, fines, all applicable taxes, all business costs and other losses resulting from a Warrantable Failure.

Limitations

Cummins is not responsible for failures or damage resulting from what Cummins determines to be abuse or neglect, including, but not limited to: operation without adequate coolants or lubricants; overfueling; overspeeding; lack of maintenance of lubricating, cooling or intake systems; improper storage, starting, warm-up, run-in or shutdown practices; unauthorized modifications of the Package. Cummins is also not responsible for failures caused by incorrect oil, fuel or diesel exhaust fluid or by water, dirt or other contaminants in the fuel, oil or diesel exhaust fluid.

Before a claim for excessive oil consumption will be considered, Owner must submit adequate documentation to show that consumption exceeds Cummins published standards.

Failures of belts and hoses supplied by Cummins are not covered beyond the first 500 hours or one year of operation, whichever occurs first.

Parts used to repair a Warrantable Failure may be new Cummins parts, Cummins approved rebuilt parts or repaired parts. Cummins is not responsible for failures resulting from the use of parts not approved by Cummins.

A new Cummins or Cummins approved rebuilt part used to repair a Warrantable Failure assumes the identity of the part it replaced and is entitled to the remaining Coverage hereunder.

CUMMINS DOES NOT COVER WEAR OR WEAROUT OF COVERED PARTS.

CUMMINS IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

THESE WARRANTIES SET FORTH HEREIN ARE THE SOLE WARRANTIES MADE BY CUMMINS IN REGARD TO THESE PACKAGES. CUMMINS MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, OR OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

In case of consumer sales, in some countries, the Owner has statutory rights which cannot be affected or limited by the terms of this Warranty.

Nothing in this Warranty excludes or restricts any contractual rights the Owner may have against third parties.
