



## 503-040 Additional New Engine Warranty Coverages

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Outlined below is specific warranty coverage information for new engines.

### Package Units

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When a product is defined as a Package Unit, **all components** of the product which were purchased from Cummins **have the same Base Engine Warranty coverage as the engine.**

**NOTE: PTO clutches are not included in package unit coverage.**

**B/ISB and C/ISC Series** Package units include:

1. **Power units built by a Cummins Distributor** when the following components, as a minimum, are purchased from Cummins:
  - Engine
  - Pedestal Feet
  - Radiator
  - Fan
2. **Marine propulsion units built by a Cummins Distributor.** Only options released by and purchased from Cummins and installed by a Cummins Distributor are covered.
3. Configuration number must be changed before claim will be accepted.
4. Package Unit designations are:
  - P - Power Units. Configurations PX.
  - F, F1, F2 - Fire Pump Drive Engines. Configurations FX and CF.
  - M - Marine Propulsion/Auxiliary Engines. Configurations ME, MX, MM and MS.

**Marine drive units sold to marinizers** such as Vetus, Thornycroft, Mermaid and Nageva have no warranty except through the selling distributor. Other locations are not to submit claims.

**Package units for other engines** (B & C Series excluded) include products built and sold by Cummins with the following model identifications:

- P - Power Units. Configurations PX.
- F, F1, F2 - Fire Pump Drive Engines. Configurations FX and CF.
- M - Marine Propulsion/Auxiliary Engines. Configurations ME, MX, MM and MS.

### Cummins Power Products

All Cummins Power Products units are covered by standard industrial Base Engine Warranty. In addition to the engine, the following power unit upfit components will be covered:

**NOTE: Cummins Power Product (CPP) parts need to be held to give the Cummins Power products group time to receive the claim from Cummins Inc. and then contact the agent for any clarification or parts return needs. Parts need to be retained for 90 days from the claim payment date. If the agent is not contacted in that time, the components can be discarded.**

**NOTE: CPP service replacement parts should be ordered directly from the New Hudson, Michigan facility (248) 573-1600.**

* CPP uses Cummins branded alternators and starters which are covered under the Base Engine Warranty by Cummins Inc. Starter solenoid/magnetic switches are also covered by Base Engine Warranty when supplied by Cummins Inc. on the base engine.

Engines used in Cummins Power Products Power Units will be identified with a CP in its technical configuration number, found on the Engine Dataplate on QuickServe® Online. If during a repair an incorrect configuration is found in IMS, contact the CPP Production Scheduler at (248) 573-1600 prior to filing a warranty claim.

All claims for warrantable repairs on CPP, power units must be submitted as follows:

- All diesel power units (Cummins Inc.) submit through BMS
- K19 Natural Gas, submit to Cummins via BMS.
- All claims for CPP gas power units should be routed through the standard electronic submission process for Cummins claims.
- Cummins Standard Repair Times (SRTs) exist for the above components and should be used for CPP upfit components as well.
- In accordance with the Cummins Inc. stated warranty policy, CPP will not reimburse inbound freight on warranty claims.
- CPP service replacement parts should be ordered directly from the New Hudson, Michigan facility (248) 573-1600 (ask for parts rep). CPP components do not have a Cummins part number and require additional information to process warranty claims. All CPP components must be claimed **at cost** in the “Other Claimables” section of the warranty claim. Markup should be calculated at 25% of cost and claimed as a separate line item in the “Other Claimables” section. In the narrative portion of the claim the following should be included for **each** CPP part used in the repair.

1. “This is a CPP Package unit.”
2. Part Quantity
3. CPP Part Number
4. Part Description
5. Part Cost
6. Part Markup

**NOTE: If the ESN is not CNGE (Cummins Natural Gas Engine - Clovis, New Mexico), please use the correct account code associated with the claim. For example:**

- 67 = New Engine Warranty
- 62 = New Parts Warranty
- 97 = ReCon® Parts Warranty
- CAPS Certificate = Use the appropriate CAPS Account Code and Authorization.
